

**29th International and National Seniors Golf
Championship of Hungary
Hungarian Golf Club, Kisoroszi July 3-5. 2018**

Conditions of Competition: The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A, the General Conditions of Competitions and the Conditions of the Ranking List Tournaments of the HGF, and in accordance with the local rules of the Hungarian Golf Club.

Eligibility: National and foreign amateur seniors whose golf club is affiliated to the Hungarian Golf Federation or a Foreign Golf Union. Entries will be accepted from senior men above 55 years of age and senior ladies above 50 years of age. For super senior category entry over 70 years of age.

The number of players is a maximum of 120 including every category. If the number of entries exceeds 120, entries of players with the lowest HCPs will be accepted by the Championship Committee considering the proportionate number of players entered each category. There will be reserved list for entries above the 120.

Competition: The Championship is played three consecutive days over 54 (3x18) holes in stroke play.

Handicap Limits: men -28.0, women -36.0

Deadline for Entry: (Wednesday) June 27th 2018 until 6 p.m.

Please note that entries by phone calls are not accepted.

Entry Fee: Euro 160 -, which includes the green fee for the practice round and green fee for the 3 days of the competition, prize-giving ceremony and lunch before. *The payment shall perform following the instruction on the Entry form.*

Starting Time: (Tuesday) 3rd July 2018, 8.00 a.m. and every 10 minutes after. Information about the tee time is available from 12 p.m. on (Monday) 2nd July 2018. on the PCCaddy Golf system www.pccaddie.net and on the www.seniorgolf.hu.

Start List: Starting on the 1st competition day will be based on HCPs in ascending order, on the 2nd competition day based on the competitors' score after 18 holes in ascending order and on the 3rd day players with the highest aggregate gross scores (based on the results of the first two days) in descending order tee off first. Flights of three composition will be based on categories.

Practice Day: (Monday) 2nd July 2018 (for tee time call: +36 26 592020).

Tees: For men: yellow, for women: red, for super senior: blue

Balls: The ball the player plays must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A.

Score cards: The scoring area where the scores may be checked and the score-cards must be returned is the terrace of the clubhouse and the clubhouse. After returning the score-card and leaving the scoring area it is prohibited to make any alteration on the score-card.

Prize Giving Ceremony: (Thursday) 5th July 2018, approx. 1 hour after closing of the tournament.

Prizes:

International Championship

Men: Gross prizes for the first 3 places (HCP 0-28.0)
Net prizes for the first 3 places (HCP 14.0-28.0)

Master: Gross prizes for the first 3 places
Net prizes for the first 3 places

Ladies: Gross prizes for the first 3 places
Net prizes for the first 3 places

In the International Championship each player can receive only one prize.

National Championship

Men: Gross prizes for the first 3 places

Master: Gross prizes for the first 3 places

Ladies: Gross prizes for the first 3 places

In the event of a tie for the first place in gross competition the winner will be decided by a hole by hole playoff ('sudden-death') on holes defined by the Championship Committee. For any further ties, the scores of the last 18, 9, 6, 3, 1 hole shall be considered. Any further tie will be decided by computer lot.

International Team Competition: An unofficial team competition is being organized amongst the players in the following categories: Men and Ladies. Any four players (from the same country) may form a team in their category. The net score (Stroke-HCP) of the teams will be calculated after each day by using the best three net results of the four players. The final result will be the summary of the 3 days. Results are calculated for each category if there are at least three participating teams. If there are 3-4 teams, only the winning team will be awarded, if there are at least five teams, then I., II., and III. places are awarded. Entry is free, filling out a team registration form is necessary by 2nd July 2018.

Deadline for Claims: No later than one hour after the tournament has been finished, claims must be in written form.

Fee of Claims: Euro 70,-

E-Carts: Use of E-Carts are not allowed except for players over 70 years in the Master category.

Championship Committee, Referees: Members of the Championship Committee and the Referees will be posted on the noticeboard of the Resort.
